About the Institution:

Pandu College is a premier coeducational institution affiliated to Gauhati University and is situated along the bank of the mighty river Brahmaputra. The College has been extending services towards society by educating large number of students in various forms since its inception on 5th September, 1962. Only 14.3 km away from state's capital and about 16.5 km from Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport, the college is well connected with road transport, railway transport and airways.

Presently the college comprises 22 full-fledged departments spread over Arts, Commerce and Science disciplines. Besides, providing education at undergraduate level, seven Post Graduate courses are also offered in different subjects viz. Assamese, Education, Economics, Geography, History, Political Science and Zoology. The college has a well-equipped library with wireless internet connectivity and UGC INFLIBNET-NLIST e-journal browsing facility. The under graduate and post graduate programs being offered by the college represent different cross cutting issues related to Gender, Environment and Sustainability, Human Values and Ethics. - The abstract must be followed by **03 to 05 keywords**.
- Full papers should be 2500-3000 words.
- The papers should be typed in **Times New Roman** format, **font size 12** with **1.5 line spacing** with both sides justified.
- The title of the paper should be in font size 14, **bold**.
- **References should be in APA style.**
- The full paper should be accompanied by a declaration mentioning the paper to be original, free from plagiarism and not submitted anywhere else for presentation or publication.
- Authors should provide their Names, Designations, Affiliations, Contact Numbers and Email. Ids along with their full papers.
- The abstracts/papers should be submitted as an email attachment to naacseminarpc@gmail.com mentioning in the subject line as "Abstract/paper Submission."
